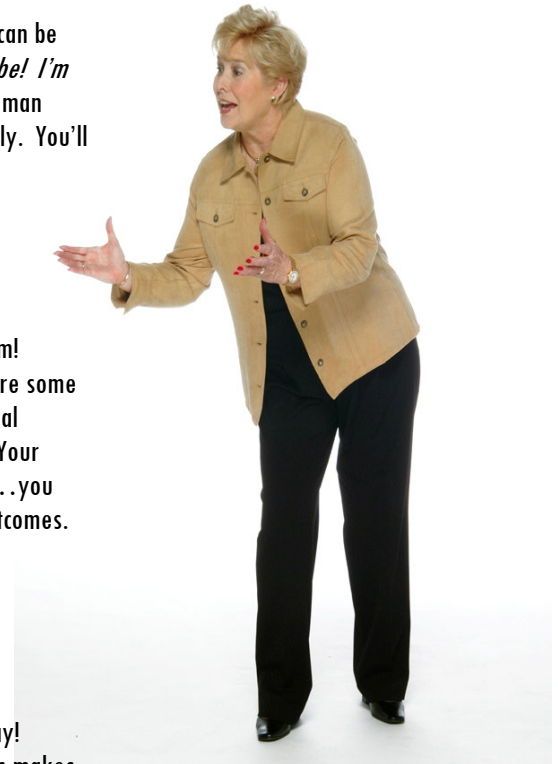
Your Thinking Drives Your Results
